

Bug Number: 72275

Insert Row Differently

Attempt #1

- 1- Open The Open Office Application
- 2- Insert Table using Toolbar (2x2 table)
- 3- Insert data in each cell (have cell with indexes of the last row and column contain a numeric digit only)
- 4- Let cursor reside on a cell on last row of respective table
- 5- Select Table>Insert>Row

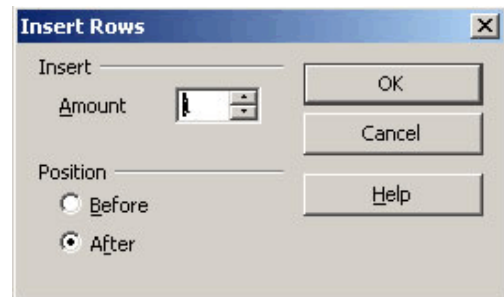


Figure 3. Screen Short Of Event

- 6- Enter 1 in the Amount Field and Select After in the Position section; if not default values (Figure 3)
- 7- Click Ok

The Edit>Undo displays 'Undo:Insert Row'.
Bug not reproduced.

Attempt #2

- 1- Open The Open Office Application
- 2- Insert Table using Toolbar (2x2 table)
- 3- Insert data in each cell (have cell with indexes of the last row and column contain a numeric digit only)
- 4- Let cursor reside on a cell on last row of respective table
- 5- Select 'Insert Row' icon of table toolbar (if table toolbar not present, insert toolbar by selecting View>Toolbar>Table, verify a check mark is beside the table feature)

The Edit>Undo displays 'Undo:Insert Row'. Bug not reproduced.

In this section I was trying to narrow the possible culprit, emphasizing on the possible variation to insert a row in a table. Also, if the bug was related to the position of the cursor when inserting a row.

Changing cell content

Attempt #1

- 1- Open The Open Office Application
- 2- Insert Table using Toolbar (2x2 table)
- 3- Insert data in each cell (have cell with indexes of the last row and last column contain a alpha characters only)
- 4- Let cursor reside on cell on last row and last column of respective table
- 5- Hit 'tab'

The Edit>Undo displays 'Undo:Insert Row'. Bug not reproduced.

Attempt #2

- 1- Open The Open Office Application
- 2- Insert Table using Toolbar (2x2 table)

3- Insert data in each cell (have cell with indexes of the last row and last column contain a alpha-numeric characters only - e.g. 2ee2, e3e, 3r3,e4ree2)

4- Let cursor reside on cell on last row and last column of respective table

5- Hit 'tab'

The Edit>Undo displays 'Undo:Insert Row'. Bug not reproduced.

In this section I was analyzing the effect of the cell contents when inserting a row.

Changing cell format

Changing the cell format did not affect the outcome of the previous tests.

Repetitive tests

Repetitive tests where done by alternating and combining the tests induced on the bug number 72275.

Tester hints bug is related to content of last cell and the manner the row is inserted. Tester concludes when the last cell contains numeric digits only and the tab is entered to designate a new row. The bug seems independent of cursor position when inserting a row as well as cell formats.

Other test would include to input numeric values from a different character set. This would test if the bug would appear on all numeric type character set or not. Unfortunately. no other character set was found nor installed for further testing.
